Pursuant to §55A-2-02 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, the undersigned Incorporator submits these Articles of Incorporation for the purpose of forming a North Carolina nonprofit corporation.

In the event of the liquidation or dissolution of the Corporation, either voluntary or involuntary, no director or officer of the Corporation or any private individual shall be entitled to any distribution or division of its remaining property or its proceeds. Upon a liquidation or dissolution the balance of all money and other property received by the Corporation from any source, after the payment of all debts and obligations of the Corporation, shall be used or distributed exclusively to an entity or entities, public or private, whose purposes are substantially similar to those set forth in these Articles of Incorporation or to an organization which would then qualify under the provisions of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and its regulations as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended.
- 9. To the extent permitted by G.S. §55A-2-02(b)(4) no director shall have any personal liability arising out of any action whether by or in the right of the Corporation or otherwise for monetary damages for breach of any duty as a director.
- 10. The Corporation shall indemnify its directors, officers, and employees to the full extent permitted by G.S. §55A-8-57.
